

## REACH: SVHC CERTIFICATE OF ABSENCE

Sir, Madam,

REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemical substances) is the European Union's settlement No. 1907/2006 / EC on registration, evaluation, authorization and restrictions of chemicals. It came into force on June 1st 2007.

REACH streamlines and improves the European Union's former legislative framework on chemicals. REACH's main puposes are a high level of protection of human health and environment against risks that chemicals can pose, the promotion of alternative test methods, the free circulation of substances on the internal market, and the enhancement of competitiveness and innovation.

During the production of our parts, as an Eco Responsible manufacturer, the PLASTIC NOBLE COMPANY (PNC) company is committed to :

- Ensuring that chemicals purchased are registered, evaluated, and authorized to use, especially in terms of pre-registration and registration of substances with the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA).
- Soliciting and examining safety data that accompany chemicals purchases, and checking labeling compliance.
- Assessing and securing the supply chain from suppliers.
- Monitoring the published list of chemicals which are assessed as potentially removed, or with limitations, in order to anticipate the options list for future impacts.

Furthermore, the PLASTIC NOBLE COMPANY (PNC) confirms that its products do not contain any of the chemical substances identified in the SVHC (Substances of Very High Concern) list, in excess of 0.1% of their mass concentration.
